



## JUDGES CONFLICT OF INTEREST FORM

To be completed at events run under WENZ rules where the Judge of any phase has a conflict of interest as set out under WENZ Rules version 1.3 (Feb 2026):

The Judge must complete a Conflict of Interest form at any WENZ affiliated show where riders they are judging fall into any of the following categories:

- The rider is riding a horse owned or leased by the judge.
- The rider has a close personal relationship with the judge.
- The rider is an employer or employee of the judge.
- Any rider who has received instruction from the judge within 14 days prior to a competition. This includes clinics or assistance in group activities as well as private instruction. If Judges wish to provide training/lessons, they should occur after the event.

If any Conflict of Interest exists, the Judge will complete and sign the form, and all riders will be notified.

*The intention is that the Organising Committee should provide each judge (Flat Work, Ease Of Handing & Speed) with a list of riders names at the start of the show, and if they have a conflict as described in the rules (above), the judge completes & signs the form and it is then displayed so that all riders are aware. There is no restriction on riders' eligibility for High Points as long as the procedure is followed correctly. A copy of the signed form(s) should be provided to WENZ.*
